
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DANGEROUS WEAPONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 134, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§134- Explosive devices; prohibitions; penalty. (a)

5 It shall be unlawful for any person to construct, set off,
6 ignite, discharge, or otherwise cause to explode any homemade
7 explosive device.

8 (b) Whoever knowingly or intentionally constructs, sets
9 off, ignites, discharges, or otherwise causes to explode any
10 homemade explosive device shall be guilty of a class C felony.

11 (c) For the purposes of this section, "homemade explosive
12 device" means a non-commercially manufactured device composed of
13 a single ingredient, or mixture of ingredients, capable of
14 instantaneously releasing a sufficient amount of energy to
15 inflict substantial damage to persons or property."
