
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VOTER REGISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) Any person qualified to and desiring to register as a
4 voter in any county shall make and subscribe to an application
5 in the form of an affidavit.

6 The affidavit shall contain the following information:

7 (1) Name;

8 (2) [~~Social~~] The last four digits of the person's social
9 security number;

10 (3) Date of birth;

11 (4) Residence, including mailing address;

12 (5) That the residence stated in the affidavit is not
13 simply because of the person's presence in the State
14 but that the residence was acquired with the intent to
15 make Hawaii the person's legal residence with all the
16 accompanying obligations therein;

17 (6) That the person is a citizen."



1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
