## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 290-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows:

3           "(f) Notwithstanding any law or ordinance to the contrary,  
4 including subsection (g), and section 46-20.5, any towing  
5 company engaged in towing in a county with a population greater  
6 than five hundred thousand shall offer towing services to  
7 consumers twenty-four hours per day every day of the week, which  
8 services shall include the release of vehicles kept in storage  
9 to a registered owner, legal owner, insurer, or a designated  
10 representative.


11           This subsection shall not apply to tow truck operators that  
12 do not store vehicles."

13           SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

14           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
