
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 141-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) Subject to legislative appropriation, moneys in the
4 special fund may be expended for the following purposes:

5 (1) The awarding of grants to farmers for agricultural
6 production or processing activity;

7 (2) The acquisition of real property for agricultural
8 production or processing activity;

9 (3) The improvement of real property, dams, reservoirs,
10 irrigation systems, and transportation networks
11 necessary to promote agricultural production or
12 processing activity[+], including investigative
13 studies to identify and assess necessary improvements
14 to dams, reservoirs, irrigation systems, and
15 transportation networks;

16 (4) The purchase of equipment necessary for agricultural
17 production or processing activity;



- 1 (5) The conduct of research on and testing of agricultural
- 2 products and markets;
- 3 (6) The funding of agricultural inspector positions within
- 4 the department of agriculture;
- 5 (7) The promotion and marketing of agricultural products
- 6 grown or raised in the State; and
- 7 (8) Any other activity intended to increase agricultural
- 8 production or processing that may lead to reduced
- 9 importation of food, fodder, or feed from outside the
- 10 State."

11 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue

12 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much

13 thereof as may be necessary, which shall be deposited into the

14 agricultural development and food security special fund and the

15 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated

16 for plans, design, engineering, investigative studies,

17 construction, renovation, repair, maintenance, and equipment for

18 dam, reservoir, or irrigation system improvements; provided that

19 no funds shall be made available from the agricultural

20 development and food security special fund under this Act unless

21 private revenues are provided to match the funds made available

22 from the agricultural development and food security special fund



1 under this Act; provided further that the priority of projects
2 shall be based on the following criteria:

- 3 (1) Dams or reservoirs with a classification of "high
4 hazard", as defined in section 179D-3, Hawaii Revised
5 Statutes; or
- 6 (2) Dams or reservoirs with a high degree of existing or
7 potential dam or reservoir safety improvements
8 pursuant to Phase I or Phase II investigations.

9 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
10 department of finance for the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
