# HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE PRESERVATION OF RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT FUNDING IN  
THE PENTAGON BUDGET.

1           WHEREAS, the defense industry plays a significant role in  
2 the growth of the state economy; and  
3

4           WHEREAS, Hawaii is the home base for a significant number  
5 of United States military commands, including combat forces of  
6 all of the service branches, world-class testing and development  
7 sites, and the Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard; and  
8

9           WHEREAS, these military assets provide a unique opportunity  
10 to aid in establishing an ecosystem essential to sustaining  
11 growth in innovation; and

13           WHEREAS, fostering and encouraging innovation is essential  
14 to a comprehensive economic strategy for the State; and  
15

16           WHEREAS, research and development is the foundation of  
17 innovation; and  
18

19           WHEREAS, Pentagon budget proposals for fiscal year 2012  
20 indicate a marked reduction in funding for research and  
21 development; and

23           WHEREAS, preserving funding for research and development in  
24 the Pentagon budget would potentially provide needed stimulus  
25 and support to the state economy; now, therefore,

27           BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
28 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session  
29 of 2012, that the Obama Administration, the United States  
30 Congress, the United States Department of Defense, the Governor,  
31 and the Military Affairs Council of the Chamber of Commerce of  
32 Hawaii are urged to do everything within their power and



1 influence to preserve research and development funding in the  
2 Pentagon budget; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
5 Resolution be transmitted to the President of the United States,  
6 the Secretary of Defense of the United States, the Chairman of  
7 the Joint Chiefs of Staff, Hawaii's congressional delegation,  
8 the Governor, and the Chairperson of the Military Affairs  
9 Council of the Chamber of Commerce of Hawaii.
