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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$13,075,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year 2012-2013,  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the seventh  
6 senatorial district, as follows:

4 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital  
5 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
6 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are  
7 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are  
8 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.

9 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
10 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
11 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

- 12 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1, 3, 5, and 6 shall be  
13 expended by the department of education; and
- 14 (2) The sums appropriated in items 2 and 4 shall be  
15 expended by the department of land and natural  
16 resources.

17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
