A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
NINETEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$78,200,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year 2012-2013,
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 nineteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Barbers Point elementary school

9 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
10 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
11 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
12 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
13 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.

14 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
15 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
16 expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of
17 this Act; provided that:

- 18 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 7 shall be
- 19 expended by the department of education; and
- 20 (2) The sum appropriated in item 8 shall be expended by
- 21 the Hawaii Community Development Authority; and




1 (3) The sums appropriated in items 9 and 10 shall be
2 expended by the department of transportation.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
