A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
SIXTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The sixth senatorial district, encompassing the
2 islands of Moloka'i, Lana'i, and Kaho'olawe, Hana, and east and
3 upcountry Maui, is one of the "canoe" districts. Thus, each
4 island area has vastly different capital improvement project
5 needs.

6 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for capital
7 improvement projects in the sixth senatorial district.

8 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
9 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$95,313,000 or so much
10 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
11 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2012-2013
12 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the sixth
13 senatorial district, as follows:

14 1. Maui Community College, Molokai campus

12 SECTION 3. The appropriations made for the capital
 13 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 14 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
 15 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
 16 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.

17 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated for the respective
 18 capital improvement projects set forth in section 2 shall be
 19 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

20 (1) The sum appropriated in item 1 shall be expended by
 21 the University of Hawaii;



- 1 (2) The sums appropriated in items 2, 14, 16, and 17 shall
2 be expended by the department of health;
- 3 (3) The sums appropriated in items 3, 6, 7, 11, 13, and 15
4 shall be expended by the department of education;
- 5 (4) The sums appropriated in items 4, 5, 8, 9, and 12
6 shall be expended by the department of land and
7 natural resources;
- 8 (5) The sum appropriated in item 10 shall be expended by
9 the department of human services; and
- 10 (6) The sums appropriated in items 18 through 26 shall be
11 expended by the department of transportation.

12 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
