A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FIFTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$10,834,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year 2012-2013,
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 fifteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Aliamanu Elementary School

8 A. Design, construction, and
9 equipment for expansion of the
10 administration building; ground
11 and site improvements; equipment
12 and appurtenances.

14 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
15 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
16 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
17 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.


18 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
