A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MILK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§321- Unpasteurized milk. Milk produced by a hoofed
5 animal shall not be required to be pasteurized if the milk is
6 intended for personal consumption or personal use by the owner
7 or by the milk producer of the hoofed animal producing the
8 particular milk.

9 For purposes of this section, "milk producer" means any
10 person who operates a dairy farm and provides, sells, or offers
11 any milk for sale to a milk plant, receiving station, or
12 transfer station."

13 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
