A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that public utilities

 commissioners who live on neighbor islands are required to spend

 an inordinate amount of travel expenses and travel time to meet

 in Honolulu for required administrative proceedings. The public

- 15 a per diem allowance equal to that paid to members of the

- 17 and hearings on Oahu.
