A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILDREN AND YOUTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:
3 **"§8-11 Children and Youth Day and Month.** The first Sunday
4 in October shall be known and designated as "Children and Youth
5 Day", and the entire month of October shall be known and
6 designated as "Children and Youth Month". Public events
7 celebrating Children and Youth Day shall be held on the grounds
8 of the state capitol on the first Sunday in October, if the
9 Children and Youth Day planning committee so chooses, unless
10 otherwise determined by the governor. This day and month are
11 not and shall not be construed to be state holidays."

12 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
