
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILDREN AND YOUTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§8-11 Children and Youth Day and Month.** (a) The first
4 Sunday in October shall be known and designated as "Children and
5 Youth Day", and the entire month of October shall be known and
6 designated as "Children and Youth Month". This day and month
7 are not and shall not be construed to be state holidays.

8 (b) If the Children and Youth Day planning committee so
9 chooses and unless otherwise determined by the governor, public
10 events celebrating Children and Youth Day shall be held on the
11 grounds of the state capitol on the first Sunday in October, and
12 public events such as the Children and Youth Summit shall be
13 held on the grounds of the state capitol in the month of
14 October."

15 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Description:

Requires public events celebrating Children and Youth Day to be held on state capitol grounds on the first Sunday in October, and public events such as the Children and Youth Summit to be held in the month of October, if the Children and Youth Day planning committee so chooses, unless otherwise determined by the governor.
