Section 84-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) The disclosure of financial interest required by this section shall be filed: 4 Between January 1 and [May-31] January 15 of each 5 (1)6 vear; Within thirty days of one's election or appointment to 7 (2) a state position enumerated in subsection (c); or 8 9 (3) Within thirty days of separation from a state position if a prior financial disclosure statement for the 10 position was not filed within the one hundred eighty 11 days preceding the date of separation; 12 provided that candidates for state elective offices or the 13 constitutional convention shall file the required statements no 14 15 later than twenty days prior to the date of the primary election for state offices or the election of delegates to the 16 constitutional convention." 17
