
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY AND BUDGET RESERVE FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the national and
2 global economic crisis that began in the second half of 2008 has
3 caused significant economic problems in numerous industries in
4 the State, including the airline, cruise ship, tourist, and
5 construction industries. Mass layoffs have been reported by an
6 increasing number of Hawaii businesses statewide, from the
7 agricultural sector to the medical-services sector. Difficult
8 economic times and declining tax revenues have resulted in
9 budget cuts for all state services.

10 The current and impending situation jeopardizes the safety
11 net of basic human services, health, and education needs for
12 Hawaii's residents and families. While all of Hawaii's
13 residents will be affected by the situation, gap group families
14 and families closest to the poverty line will suffer the most.

15 Pursuant to Act 304, Session Laws of Hawaii 1999, the
16 legislature established the emergency and budget reserve fund,
17 which is codified in section 328L-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as
18 a temporary supplemental source of funding for the State of



1 Hawaii in times of emergency, economic downturn, or unforeseen
2 reduction in revenues. As set forth in section 328L-3, Hawaii
3 Revised Statutes, specific purposes for the fund include
4 maintaining levels of programs determined to be essential to
5 public health, safety, welfare, and education. Section 328L-3,
6 Hawaii Revised Statutes, also includes certain prohibitions on
7 appropriations from the emergency and budget reserve fund.
8 Appropriations for the following purposes are specifically
9 prohibited:

- 10 (1) To meet expenses of the legislature;
- 11 (2) To provide for salary adjustments for officials
12 appointed pursuant to article V, section 6; or article
13 VI, section 3, of the Hawaii State Constitution and
14 for others whose salaries are directly related to
15 salaries of these officials; and
- 16 (3) To fund cost items in any collective bargaining
17 contract.

18 The legislature finds that expenditures from the emergency
19 and budget reserve fund are needed to meet the conditions of
20 emergency, economic downturn, and unforeseen reduction in
21 revenues that the State currently faces. Further, the
22 legislature finds that the appropriations in this Act are



1 consistent with the purposes of the emergency and budget reserve
2 fund.

3 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys from the
4 emergency and budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii to
5 maintain the levels of programs determined to be essential to
6 education, public health, and public welfare.

7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
8 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
9 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
10 year 2012-2013 for respite services.

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
12 health for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
14 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
15 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
16 year 2012-2013 to supplement the healthy start program.

17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
18 health for the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
20 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
21 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal



1 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
2 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes to:

3 (1) Catholic Charities Hawai'i for Lanakila Multi-Purpose
4 Senior Center \$;

5 (2) Moiliili Community Center for Moiliili Senior Center
6 Program \$; and

7 (3) Waikiki Community Center \$.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
9 health for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
11 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
12 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
13 year 2012-2013 for the kupuna care program.

14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
15 health for the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
17 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
18 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
19 year 2012-2013 for the aging and disability resource center.

20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
21 health for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
2 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
3 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
4 year 2012-2013 for the developmental disabilities medicaid
5 waiver program.

6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
7 health for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
9 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
10 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
11 year 2012-2013 for mental health services.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
13 health for the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
15 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
16 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
17 year 2012-2013 for the partnerships in community living program.

18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
19 health for the purposes of this Act.

20 SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
21 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of



1 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
2 year 2012-2013 for substance abuse treatment.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
4 health for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
6 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of

7 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
8 year 2012-2013 for the healthy aging partnership program.

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
10 health for the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
12 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of

13 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
14 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
15 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Waianae District
16 Comprehensive Health and Hospital Board, Inc., to support its
17 emergency room services.

18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
19 health for the purposes of this Act.

20 SECTION 13. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
21 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of

22 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal



1 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
2 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for HIV/AIDS related services and
3 to be distributed as follows:

- 4 (1) Life Foundation \$;
- 5 (2) Gregory House Programs \$; and
- 6 (3) Community Health Outreach Work to
7 Prevent AIDS \$.

8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
9 of health for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 14. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
11 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
12 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
13 year 2012-2013 to fund the housing first pilot program, through
14 a collaboration between the Hawaii public housing authority and
15 the department of human services, for chronically homeless
16 individuals, including those who have an addiction or mental
17 illness, or both.

18 The department of human services shall prepare a report to
19 the legislature on the progress of the housing first pilot
20 program and submit the report to the legislature no later than
21 twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
22 2013.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 human services for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 15. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
4 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
5 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
6 year 2012-2013 for meals for the elderly for kupuna care.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
8 health's executive office on aging for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 16. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
10 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
11 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
12 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
13 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Kokua Kalihi Valley
14 (Comprehensive Family Services).

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
16 health for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 17. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
18 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
19 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
20 year 2012-2013 to be administered by the department of health
21 for services to pregnant women struggling with addiction.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 health for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 18. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
4 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
5 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
6 year 2012-2013 for the baby S.A.F.E. (substance abuse free
7 environment) program.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
9 health for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 19. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
11 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
12 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
13 year 2012-2013 for fetal alcohol spectrum disorders.

14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
15 health for the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 20. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
17 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
18 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
19 year 2012-2013 for family planning.

20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
21 health for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 21. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
2 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
3 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
4 year 2012-2013 for perinatal health programs.

5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
6 health for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 22. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
8 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
9 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
10 year 2012-2013 for the preschool developmental screening
11 program.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
13 health for the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 23. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
15 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
16 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
17 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
18 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Blueprint for Change for
19 neighborhood place walk-in centers.

20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
21 human services for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 24. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
 2 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
 3 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 4 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
 5 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Primary Care
 6 Association for the Hawaii immigrant health initiative program
 7 provided at federally qualified health centers.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department
 9 human services for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 25. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
 11 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
 12 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 13 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
 14 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to support domestic violence
 15 shelters statewide and to be distributed as follows:

- 16 (1) Child and Family Service;
- 17 (A) Two shelters on Oahu \$; and
- 18 (B) Two shelters on Big Island \$;
- 19 (2) Parents and Children Together \$;
- 20 (3) Women Helping Women \$;
- 21 (4) Molokai Community Service
- 22 Council, Inc. \$;



- 1 (5) Young Women's Christian Association
- 2 (YWCA) of Kauai \$;
- 3 (6) Windward Spouse Abuse Shelter \$; and
- 4 (7) Statewide domestic violence shelters \$.

5 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
 6 of human services for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 26. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
 8 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
 9 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 10 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
 11 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Hale Mahaolu for personal care
 12 services.

13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
 14 human services for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 27. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
 16 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
 17 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 18 year 2012-2013 for the shelter plus care program.

19 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
 20 human services for the purposes of this Act.

21 SECTION 28. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
 22 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of



1 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
2 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
3 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Primary Care
4 Association for adult dental care provided at federally
5 qualified health centers; provided that the funds shall not be
6 used for any other purpose. The governor is authorized to
7 utilize enhanced federal medical assistance percentages funds to
8 offset the amount appropriated; provided that the total amount
9 shall not exceed \$. The department of human services
10 shall prepare a report on:

- 11 (1) The number of adults receiving these benefits;
- 12 (2) The cost per person;
- 13 (3) Total breakdown of administrative costs and other
14 overhead costs; and
- 15 (4) Statistics, if available, on how this dental program
16 is reducing the number of emergency dental-related
17 medical procedures;

18 provided that the department of human services shall submit its
19 report to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
20 convening of the 2013 regular session.

21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
22 human services for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 29. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
2 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
3 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
4 year 2012-2013 for Maui community college, University of Hawaii,
5 for the adult dental care program.

6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
7 human services for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 30. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
9 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
10 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
11 year 2012-2013 for outstationed eligibility worker services
12 provided at federally qualified health centers.

13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
14 human services for the purposes of this Act.

15 SECTION 31. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
16 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
17 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
18 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
19 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Primary Care
20 Association for outreach services provided at federally
21 qualified health centers.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 human services for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 32. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
4 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
5 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
6 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
7 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Primary Care
8 Association for outreach services to locate uninsured children
9 provided at federally qualified health centers.

10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
11 human services for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 33. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
13 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
14 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
15 year 2012-2013 for child care subsidies.

16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
17 human services for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 34. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
19 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
20 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
21 year 2012-2013 for the general assistance program under section
22 346-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to maintain the general



1 assistance benefit amount at \$ per person per month or
2 as close to \$ per person per month as possible, given
3 the monthly caseload.

4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
5 human services for the purposes of this Act.

6 SECTION 35. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
7 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
8 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
9 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
10 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Adult Friends for Youth for
11 youth gang prevention and intervention services.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
13 human services for the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 36. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
15 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
16 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
17 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
18 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Hawaii Centers for Independent
19 Living for statewide independent living services.

20 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
21 human services for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 37. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
2 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
3 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
4 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
5 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Susannah Wesley Community
6 Center for the Susannah Wesley Community Center Youth Service
7 Center.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
9 human services for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 38. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
11 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
12 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
13 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
14 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Planned Parenthood of Hawaii
15 for statewide sexual health education.

16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
17 health for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 39. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
19 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
20 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
21 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter



1 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Partners in Development
2 Foundation to:

3 (1) Provide comprehensive family training (early
4 childhood, parent, adult education, and intensive
5 child-caregiver activities) and transitional services
6 to sheltered and unsheltered homeless families on the
7 leeward coast of Oahu;

8 (2) Offer early screening, assessment, and referral
9 services for homeless children from birth to age five;
10 and

11 (3) Prepare homeless children for kindergarten by
12 providing developmentally appropriate social,
13 emotional, and cognitive activities in a child-
14 caregiver interactive learning environment.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
16 human services for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 40. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
18 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of

19 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
20 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
21 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to PATCH (People Attentive to
22 Children) for the preschool open doors program.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 human services for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 41. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
4 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
5 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
6 year 2012-2013 for domestic violence services.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
8 the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 42. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
10 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
11 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
12 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
13 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Volunteer Legal Services Hawai'i
14 to provide pro bono legal services for indigent persons.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
16 the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 43. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
18 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
19 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
20 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
21 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Legal Aid Society of Hawai'i
22 to provide general civil legal services.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
2 the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 44. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
4 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
5 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
6 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
7 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for the Hawaii Family Law Clinic
8 to provide services to obtain temporary restraining orders.

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
10 the purposes of this Act.

11 SECTION 45. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
12 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
13 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
14 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
15 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Catholic Charities Hawaii
16 to provide intra-familial sex assault services.

17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
18 the purposes of this Act.

19 SECTION 46. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
20 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
21 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
22 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter



1 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to The Children's Alliance of
2 Hawaii, Inc., to provide child sex assault services.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
4 the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 47. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
6 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
7 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
8 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
9 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Young Men's Christian
10 Association of Honolulu for the operation of the weed and seed
11 program in Kalihi-Palama, Waipahu, and Ewa Beach.

12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary for
13 the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 48. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
15 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
16 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
17 year 2012-2013 for the office of community services for
18 employment core services.

19 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
20 labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.

21 SECTION 49. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
22 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of



1 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 2 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
 3 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Hawaii Disability Rights
 4 Center to provide advocacy service to individuals with
 5 developmental disabilities and mental illness.

6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
 7 labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.

8 SECTION 50. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
 9 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of

10 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 11 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
 12 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Kapi'olani Medical Center
 13 for Women and Children for the sex abuse treatment center for
 14 statewide sex assault services.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
 16 the attorney general for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 51. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
 18 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of

19 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
 20 year 2012-2013 for the Families for R.E.A.L. program.

21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
 22 education for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 52. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
2 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
3 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
4 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
5 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Read Aloud America, Inc., for
6 the read aloud program.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
8 education for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 53. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
10 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
11 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
12 year 2012-2013 to provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter
13 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to Read To Me International
14 Foundation for reading programs for children of incarcerated
15 parents.

16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
17 education for the purposes of this Act.

18 SECTION 54. There is appropriated out of the emergency and
19 budget reserve fund of the State of Hawaii the sum of
