RELATING TO DEFENDANTS COMMITTED TO THE CUSTODY OF THE DIRECTOR OF HEALTH.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 704, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to re	ad as follows:
4	" <u>§70</u>	4- Committed persons; transfer to a correctional
5	facility.	(1) Any person committed to the custody of the
6	director	of health pursuant to section 704-406, 704-411(1), or
7	704-413(3	), may be transferred to a correctional facility as
8	determine	d by the director of public safety, when, upon the
9	filing of	a petition by the director of health, the court of
10	original	jurisdiction finds that:
11	<u>(a)</u>	The person no longer requires inpatient clinical
12		support and the person's mental health needs can be
13		adequately addressed at a correctional facility;
14	<u>(b)</u>	The person no longer requires inpatient clinical
15		support but is not otherwise suitable for discharge
16		into a less restrictive community or residential
17		treatment setting; or

1	<u>(c)</u>	The person requires stricter security than can be	
2		provided for at the Hawaii state hospital or other	
3		facility designated by the director of health.	
4	(2)	The director of health or the director's designee	
5	shall wor	k with the correctional facility in creating an	
6	adequate mental health plan for any person transferred pursuant		
7	to this section.		
8	(3) Should the clinical needs of any person transferred to		
9	a correctional facility pursuant to this section require		
10	inpatient clinical support services, that person may be		
11	recommitted to a facility under the control of the director of		
12	health pursuant to a court order, as a pretrial detainee or		
13	resident in need of treatment.		
14	(4) Nothing in this section shall prohibit the director of		
15	public sa	fety from transferring a person to an out-of-state	
16	correction	nal facility pursuant to section 353-16.2."	
17	SECT	ION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that	
18	matured,	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were	
19	begun bef	ore its effective date.
