A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTY-FOURTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$23,415,500 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2012-2013
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the twenty-
6 fourth senatorial district, as follows:

6 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
7 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
8 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
9 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
10 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.

11 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
12 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
13 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

- 14 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 to 17 shall be
15 expended by the department of education;
- 16 (2) The sums appropriated in items 18 to 21 shall be
17 expended by the department of land and natural
18 resources;
- 19 (3) The sum appropriated in item 22 shall be expended by
20 the department of health; and
- 21 (4) The sums appropriated in items 23 to 27 shall be
22 expended by the department of transportation.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
