# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIQUOR.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 281-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) Class 1. Manufacturer license. A license for the  
4 manufacture of liquor shall authorize the licensee to  
5 [manufacture];

6 (1) Manufacture the liquor therein specified [~~and to~~  
7 ~~sell~~];

8 (2) Sell it at wholesale in original packages to any  
9 person who holds a license to resell it [~~and to sell~~];  
10 and

11 (3) Sell draught beer, [~~or~~] wine manufactured from grapes  
12 or other fruits grown in the State, or other specified  
13 liquor manufactured from fruits or other products  
14 grown in the State in any quantity to any person for  
15 private use and consumption.

16 Under this license, no liquor shall be consumed on the  
17 premises except as authorized by the commission. Of this class,  
18 there shall be the following kinds:



- 1 (1) Beer;
- 2 (2) Wine;
- 3 (3) Alcohol; and
- 4 (4) Other specified liquor.

5 It shall be unlawful for any holder of a manufacturer  
 6 license to have any interest whatsoever in the license or  
 7 licensed premises of any other licensee. This subsection shall  
 8 not prevent the holder of a manufacturer license under this  
 9 chapter or under the law of another jurisdiction from  
 10 maintaining any interest in the license or licensed premises of  
 11 a wholesale dealer licensee under this chapter."

12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
