# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. (a) The department of education and board of  
2 education shall develop policies and procedures to allow home-  
3 schooled students to participate on an equal basis in  
4 extracurricular activities offered at the public school that the  
5 home-schooled students would otherwise be required to attend.

6           (b) In developing policies and procedures pursuant to  
7 subsection (a), the department of education and the board of  
8 education shall examine the following:

9           (1) The imposition of participation fees as a requisite to  
10 participate in extracurricular activities;

11           (2) The inclusion of home-schooled students who  
12 participate in extracurricular activities in the pupil  
13 enrollment of the public school where the student  
14 participates; and

15           (3) Any other eligibility requirements for participation  
16 by home-schooled students.

17           (c) The department of education shall report its findings,  
18 including the status of the development of policies and



1 procedures pursuant to subsection (a), to the legislature no  
2 later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular  
3 session of 2012.

4 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Home Schooling; Extracurricular Activities

**Description:**

Requires DOE and BOE to develop policies and procedures to allow home-schooled students to participate on an equal basis in extracurricular activities offered at the public school they would otherwise be required to attend. Requires a report to the legislature prior to 2012 regular session. Effective 7/1/2050.
