A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ARMED FORCES SERVICE MEMBERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 338, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§338- Disposition of body; armed forces service
5 members. The person designated by the decedent as authorized to
6 direct disposition on a United States Department of Defense
7 Record of Emergency Data, DD Form 93, or its successor form, may
8 arrange for the final disposition of the decedent's body,
9 including cremation, if the decedent:

10 (1) Died while serving in any branch of the United States
11 armed forces, United States reserve forces, or
12 national guard; and

13 (2) Executed the United States Department of Defense
14 Record of Emergency Data, DD Form 93, or its successor
15 form."

16 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.


