Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.B. No. 1330, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOBACCO SETTLEMENT
SPECIAL FUND,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to provide continued support to
the John A. Burns School of Medicine (JABSOM) by extending the
authorization that allocates a portion of Hawaii Tobacco
Settlement Special Fund moneys to fund JABSOM operating expenses.

The University of Hawaii System, University of Hawaii Cancer
Center, Healthcare Association of Hawaii, Hawaii Medical
Association, The Queen's Health Systems, Hawaii Pacific Health,
Hawaii Medical Service Association, and The Chamber of Commerce of
Hawaii supported this bill. The Coalition for a Tobacco-Free
Hawaii opposed this measure. The Department of Health and
American Cancer Society provided comments.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report,
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B.
No. 1330, H.D. 1, and recommends that it be referred to the
Committee on Finance.
