Sir:

Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 1876
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO DENTAL HYGIENISTS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to require a dental
hygienist's license to practice to be prominently displayed at all
times in the dental hygienist's office.

The Board of Dental Examiners, Hawaii Dental Hygienists'
Association, American Dental Hygienists' Association-Hawaii, and
many concerned individuals testified in support of this bill.

Your Committee requests that subsequent committee discussions
include requiring copies, instead of the originals, of dental
hygienist certificates of license to be displayed in offices of
employment and requiring licensure, renewal, and expiration dates
to be on all certificates of license.

Your Committee has amended this bill by requiring both the
license certificate and annual registration certificate to be
displayed in the office in which the dental hygienist is employed
or practices.


As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
