The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds to establish a medical residency program at the University of Hawaii at Hilo.

Hawaii Medical Association; Hawaii Health Systems
Corporation, East Hawaii Region; Hawaii Health Systems
Corporation, West Hawaii Region; Hawaii Island Rural Family
Practice Residency Program; Hilo Medical Center Foundation; Puna
Community Medical Center; Hawaii Island Healthcare Alliance;
Hawaii Island Chamber of Commerce; Kona-Kohala Chamber of
Commerce; Rotary Club of Hilo; Rotary Club of South Hilo
Foundation; and numerous individuals testified in support of this
measure. The Department of Health, Hawaii Health Systems
Corporation, and the Chancellor of the University of Hawaii at
Hilo testified in support of the intent of this measure.

In discussion, your Committees noted the suggestion to change the expending agency in the measure from the University of Hawaii at Hilo, to Hilo Medical Center.
