H.B. No. 2529 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN  
HOME LANDS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to exempt expenditures and  
procurements of less than \$250,000 from the Hawaiian Home  
Operating Fund, Hawaiian Home Receipts Fund, Hawaiian Home Trust  
Fund, and Native Hawaiian Rehabilitation Fund from the  
requirements of the Hawaii Public Procurement Code.


The Department of Hawaiian Home Lands, Office of Hawaiian
