Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred  
H.C.R. No. 124 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF VEHICLE IMMOBILIZATION  
AS A SANCTION FOR OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WITH A LICENSE  
REVOKED OR SUSPENDED FOR OPERATING A VEHICLE UNDER THE  
INFLUENCE OF AN INTOXICANT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the Department of  
Transportation to convene a working group to study all aspects of  
vehicle immobilization as a sanction for driving with a license  
that was revoked or suspended for operating a vehicle under the  
influence of an intoxicant.

MADD-Hawaii and the Hawaii Strategic Highway Safety Plan  
supported the resolution, the Department of Transportation  
supported the resolution with concerns involving the funding and  
the Department of Health supported the intent.

Hawaii is faced with an ever increasing problem of  
individuals operating vehicles without a valid driver's license,  
or with a canceled, suspended, or revoked driver's license. More  
than one out of every five drivers who tested positive for alcohol  
was found to be unlicensed. This resolution attempts to address  
this issue.



As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Transportation that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 124 and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Judiciary.
