H.C.R. No. 146 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF
COMMERCE AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS AND THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF
SOCIAL WORKERS, HAWAII CHAPTER, TO DEVELOP CONTINUING
EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSED SOCIAL WORKERS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the Department of
Commerce and Consumer Affairs and the National Association of
Social Workers, Hawaii Chapter, to:

- (1) Continue to collaborate on developing, implementing, and
monitoring continuing education requirements for all
licensed social workers in Hawaii; and
- (2) Submit to the Legislature at least 20 days prior to the
Regular Session of 2013 a proposed draft for a bill to
establish, implement, and monitor continuing education
requirements for all licensed social workers in Hawaii.

The National Association of Social Workers and several
concerned individuals supported the measure. The Department of
Commerce and Consumer Affairs offered comments on the measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Human Services that is attached to this report, your
Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 146



and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce.
