"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION TO REVIEW AND REPORT ON POLICIES RELATING TO
THE USE OF DRIVERLESS VEHICLES IN HAWAII,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request that the Department
of Transportation review its by-laws and policies, applicable
administrative rules and statutes, as well as any internal
practices and procedures.

One individual testified in support.

The Google Driverless Car is a project initiated by Google
engineers to develop technology for driverless cars, also known as
autonomous vehicles. The system combines artificial intelligence
software with video cameras and sensors to guide the vehicle
without human intervention. Vehicles such as the Toyota Prius and
Audi TT have been modified and have already been road tested in
California and Nevada. The system provides an override that allows
a human driver to take control of the vehicle. In June 2011 the
State of Nevada passed Assembly Bill No. 511 which, among other
things, authorizes the Department of Transportation to develop
rules and regulations governing the use of driverless cars.
