Your Committee on Public Safety & Military Affairs, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 219 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO DEVELOP A SIMPLIFIED REPORTING SYSTEM FOR VETERINARIANS TO COMPLY WITH PART VIII OF CHAPTER 329, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES, PERTAINING TO THE ELECTRONIC PRESCRIPTION ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM, "

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the Department of Public Safety to:

- (1) Develop by December 31, 2012, a simplified version of the electronic prescription accountability system for veterinarians;
- (2) Give veterinarians a reasonable time before they must report under the simplified version of the electronic prescription accountability system, i.e., to take place after the system is developed and veterinarians are notified of the system; and
- (3) Submit a report to the Governor, Senate President, House Speaker, Director of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, and President of the Executive Board of the Hawaii Veterinary Medical Association prior to the 2013 Regular Session, on the status of the progress made in




developing and implementing the simplified version of the electronic prescription accountability system.

No testimony was received on this measure.
