Your Committees on Agriculture and Economic Revitalization & Business, to which was referred H.R. No. 27 entitled:

"HOUSE RESOLUTION DECLARING SUNDAYS TO BE "EAT LOCAL, BUY LOCAL" DAY IN HAWAII AND ENCOURAGING FAMILIES, RESTAURANTS, AND GROCERS TO BUY HAWAII-GROWN FOODS, FLOWERS, AND PRODUCE,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to declare Sundays "Eat local, buy local" day in Hawaii to encourage families, restaurants, and grocers to buy Hawaii-grown foods, flowers, and produce.

Hawaii Department of Agriculture, Taro Security and Purity Task Force, and the Hawaii Farm Bureau Federation testified in support of this measure.

Your committee has amended this measure by adding the following:

(1) Including Saturday into the resolution.

(2) Changing 'day' to 'days.'


(3) Inserting another whereas clause that states 'majority of the local farmers markets are held on weekends.'

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your Committees on Agriculture and Economic Revitalization & Business that are attached to this report, your Committees concur with the




intent and purpose of H.R. No. 27, as amended herein, and recommend its adoption in the form attached hereto as H.R. No. 27, H.D. 1.


