Your Committee on Hawaiian Affairs, to which was referred
S.B. No. 2268 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO QUEEN LILIUOKALANI,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to modify the inscription on
the memorial statue of Queen Liliuokalani on the grounds of the
State Capitol to reflect the dates of her coronation on January
29, 1891, to the date of her death on November 11, 1917.

Currently, the inscription, "Queen of Hawaii 1891-1893",
reflects the dates of her coronation and the overthrow of the
Government of Hawaii.

The Office of Hawaiian Affairs and Association of Hawaiian
Civic Clubs supported the measure. A concerned individual opposed
the measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Hawaiian Affairs that is attached to this report,
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B.
No. 2268 and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be
referred to the Committee on Finance.


