measure.


Your Committee has amended this measure by making technical,  
nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No.  
2709, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second  
Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 2709, H.D. 1, and
