Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 2810, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT EXEMPTION FOR DOMESTIC SERVICES AUTHORIZED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, "

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to provide clarity and consistency to Hawaii's workers' compensation and temporary disability insurance laws and Prepaid Health Care Act with regard to aged recipients and disabled recipients of home- and communitybased services and recipients of Department of Human Services' state-funded home- and community-based services. Specifically, this measure amends the definition of "employment" under the workers' compensation law, temporary disability insurance law, and the Prepaid Health Care Act, by excluding from the definition, certain domestic services and day care services authorized by the Department of Human Services when performed by an individual in the employ of a recipient of social service payments.

The Department of Human Services and Department of Labor and Industrial Relations testified in support of this measure.


- (1) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2030, to facilitate further discussion; and
