Your Committee on Health, to which was referred S.B. No. 657,  
S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CHIROPRACTIC,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to update the scope of practice  
of chiropractic to reflect standards, practices, and terminology  
accepted by the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners.

The American Chiropractic Association, Hawaii State  
Chiropractic Association, Board of Chiropractic Examiners, and  
many concerned individuals testified in support of this bill. The  
Hawaii Insurers Council opposed this measure. The Hawaii Medical  
Association provided comments.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- (1) Clarifying that the imaging allowed to be used or  
ordered by licensees is for neuroskeletal purposes;
- (2) Requiring the Board of Chiropractic Examiners and  
American Chiropractic Association to work together to  
define the scope of practice for chiropractic;
- (3) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2050, to  
encourage further discussion; and



- (4) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.
