Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
S.B. No. 814, S.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO CERTAIN FUNDS OF THE
UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to provide increased efficiency
in the use and management of University of Hawaii (UH) funds by
reclassifying or repealing certain UH special, revolving, and
trust funds.

UH supported this bill.

Your Committee has amended this bill by:

- (1) Repealing, rather than amending, the Conference Center
Revolving Fund;
- (2) Directing the unencumbered balances of the Conference
Center Revolving Fund to the UH Commercial Enterprises
Revolving Fund, rather than the UH Auxiliary Enterprises
Special Fund;

- (3) Specifying that any unencumbered balances remaining in repealed funds, other than the UH Housing Assistance Revolving Fund, will be transferred to the credit of the general fund;
- (4) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2030, to encourage further discussion; and
- (5) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 814, S.D. 2, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 814, S.D. 2, H.D. 1, and be referred to the Committee on Finance.
