HONOLULU TO PRESERVE EXISTING AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND CREATE  
NEW AFFORDABLE HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES, FAMILY-ORIENTED SUPPORT  
SERVICES, HEALTH CENTERS, COMMUNITY CENTERS, RETAIL SERVICES  
RELATED TO HEALTHY LIVING, AND COMMUNITY GARDENS WITHIN

The purpose of this measure is to encourage the preservation  
and creation of affordable housing, family-oriented support  
service, health centers, community centers, retail services  
related to healthy living, and community gardens within transit-  
oriented development zones along the Honolulu Rail Transit Project  
corridor.

The City and County of Honolulu Department of Planning and  
Permitting and The Pacific Resource Partnership supported the  
measure.

Your committee finds that the preservation and expansion of  
affordable housing within the transit-oriented development (TOD)  
zones will create more economically vibrant and socially equitable  
communities. Your committee also finds that the creation of a  
community infrastructure providing support services for children

and elders, to include child care and adult care, within the TOD zones will encourage the formation of more family oriented communities.
