Your Committee on Public Safety, Government Operations, and
Military Affairs, to which was referred S.C.R. No. 30 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION A RESOLUTION URGING CONGRESS TO
AMEND THE UNFUNDED MANDATES REFORM ACT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to urge the United
States Congress to amend the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act.

Your Committee received comments from one individual.

Your Committee finds that unfunded federal mandates place
unreasonable demands on limited state resources. The Unfunded
Mandates Reform Act was adopted in 1995 to limit these mandates by
requiring accurate cost estimates of federal legislation and rule
making. Loopholes in the original legislation have prevented the
intent of the legislation from being fully implemented.

Your Committee has amended this measure by making technical,
nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and
consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Public Safety, Government Operations, and Military
Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs
with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 30, as amended herein,
and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Ways and
Means, in the form attached hereto as S.C.R. No. 30, S.D. 1.


