Sir:

Your Committee on Transportation and International Affairs,  
to which was referred S.C.R. No. 60 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION TO PROMPTLY UNDERTAKE THE DESIGN AND  
CONSTRUCTION OF A SHARED-USE PATH ALONG KAHEKILI HIGHWAY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to urge the  
Department of Transportation to expend the funds set aside in its  
capital improvement budget to promptly undertake the design and  
construction of a shared-use path along Kahekili Highway between  
East Hui 'Iwa Street and the intersection of Kahekili and  
Kamehameha Highways near the Hygienic Store.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure  
from Kahaluu Neighborhood Board No. 29 and one individual.  
Testimony in opposition was received from the Department of  
Transportation.


Your Committee finds that the Department of Transportation  
currently has a right-of-way along Kahekili Highway between East  
Hui 'Iwa Street and the intersection of Kahekili and Kamehameha  
Highways near the Hygienic Store that is wide enough to  
accommodate a shared-use path and any of the highway widening or  
contraflow options currently under construction. The Department  
of Transportation's capital improvement budget for fiscal year  
2011-2012 includes \$1,600,000 for the design and construction of a  
shared-use path along Kahekili Highway. The design and  
construction of a shared-use path could proceed expeditiously and



could provide additional construction jobs during this period of economic recovery.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Transportation and International Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 60 and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.


