Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred  
S.C.R. No. 97, S.D. 1, entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE INSURANCE  
COMMISSIONER TO CONVENE A WORKING GROUP TO EXPLORE THE  
CREATION OF A WEB SERVICES-BASED DATABASE PROGRAM TO TRACK  
UNINSURED MOTORISTS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the Insurance  
Commissioner to convene a working group to explore the creation of  
a web services-based database program to track uninsured  
motorists.

The City and County of Honolulu Department of Customer  
Services, Property Casualty Insurers Association of America (PCI)  
and GEICO supported the measure. The Department of Commerce and  
Consumer Affairs and State Farm Insurance supported the intent.  
One individual opposed the measure and one individual offered  
comments.

Your committee finds that there is no statewide motor vehicle  
registration database and no agency in the State that currently  
monitors uninsured motorists. This measure would request the  
convening of a working group to study the feasibility of  
establishing a program to track uninsured motorists and enforce  
penalties or sanctions against violators.



As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Transportation that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 97, S.D. 1, and recommends that it be referred to the Committee on Finance.
