Requires licensing boards to: (1) allow applicants to demonstrate competency in lieu of work experience required; and (2) establish procedures to expedite the issuance of licenses, certifications, or permits to military spouses.

RELATING TO TATTOO ARTISTS.

PGM/HTH, CPN

Restricts the sale of tattoo supplies. Requires blood borne pathogen test as a prerequisite for licensure beginning 1/1/2013 and every four years after initial test to continue to hold a license. Prohibits body piercing or body modifications at tattoo trade shows. Creates a tattoo artist task force. Reports to legislature.
