<a href="#">SB236</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	RELATING TO THE CONTRACTORS LICENSE BOARD. Reconfigures the composition of the contractors licensing board to include exclusive representatives of collective bargaining units, and reduce from 5 to 3 members representatives of both general and speciality contractors.	CPN
<a href="#">SB2395</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL AND VOCATIONAL LICENSING. Requires licensing boards to: (1) allow applicants to demonstrate competency in lieu of work experience required; and (2) establish procedures to expedite the issuance of licenses, certifications, or permits to military spouses. <a href="#">SB2398 SD1</a> <a href="#">(SSCR2318)</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	RELATING TO TATTOO ARTISTS. Restricts the sale of tattoo supplies. Requires blood borne pathogen test as a prerequisite for licensure beginning 1/1/2013 and every four years after initial test to continue to hold a license. Prohibits body piercing or body modifications at tattoo trade shows. Creates a tattoo artist task force. Reports to legislature. (SD1)	PGM/HTH, CPN
<a href="#">SB2945</a> <a href="#">(SSCR2272)</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	RELATING TO LIQUOR LICENSES. Authorizes the revocation or suspension of a liquor license for a continuing pattern of noise, disturbance, misconduct, or disorder.	PGM, CPN



<a href="#">SB2247 SD1</a> <a href="#">(SSCR2005)</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	<p>RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.</p> <p>Requires commercial mobile radio service providers to provide call location information upon request by public safety agencies responding to emergencies. Provides immunity from liability for commercial mobile radio service providers, its representatives, and public safety answering points for providing call information in good faith. (SD1)</p>	PGM, CPN
<a href="#">SB2394 SD1</a> <a href="#">(SSCR2054)</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	<p>RELATING TO CONSUMER PROTECTION.</p> <p>Authorizes the director of commerce and consumer affairs to enforce certain federal laws to protect military members and their families from abusive lending practices. (SD1)</p>	PGM, CPN
<a href="#">SB2108 SD1</a> <a href="#">(SSCR2163)</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	<p>RELATING TO TELECOMMUNICATIONS.</p> <p>Limits to retail basic exchange services the services for which a telecommunications carrier must obtain approval from the PUC to charge a rate higher than the filed tariff rate. (SD1)</p>	EDT, CPN
<a href="#">SB2296</a> <a href="#">(SSCR2084)</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	<p>RELATING TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE INDUSTRY LICENSING ACT.</p> <p>Requires motor vehicles to be insured prior to release from auction. Amends requirements to obtain a dealer license. Amends bond requirements in lieu of a flooring line of credit.</p>	TIA, CPN
<a href="#">SB2968 SD1</a> <a href="#">(SSCR2011)</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	<p>RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE.</p> <p>Allows motor vehicle insurers to offer insurance premium discounts for completion of a driver safety course or driver improvement course. (SD1)</p>	TIA, CPN
<a href="#">SB2089</a> <a href="#">(SSCR2043)</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	<p>RELATING TO TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS.</p> <p>Requires any nonresident owner who operates a transient accommodation located in the nonresident owner's private residence, including an apartment, unit, or townhouse, to employ a property manager approved by the real estate commission.</p>	TSM, CPN
<a href="#">SB2966 SD1</a> <a href="#">(SSCR2018)</a> <a href="#">Status and Testimony</a>	<p>RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY.</p> <p>Increases maximum allowable customer-generator capacity for net energy metering systems to two megawatts if the generating facility is sited on property owned or controlled by the State of Hawaii. Increases maximum allowable customer-generator capacity for net energy metering systems to one megawatt for all other systems. Takes effect on 7/1/2050. (SD1)</p>	ENE, CPN

RELATING TO HEALTH.

HTH, CPN

Requires health insurers to provide outpatient prescription drug coverage. Prohibits health insurers, other than mutual benefit societies, from requiring coinsurance as a basis for cost sharing with the insured for outpatient prescription drug benefits and limits the amount of copayments an insured must pay for prescription drugs. (SD1)
