[Status and Testimony](#) Makes housekeeping amendments to the law that establishes the State of Hawaii's popular name as the "Aloha State".

[SB2236](#) RELATING TO INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY. EDT
[Status and Testimony](#) Clarifies that the information technology steering committee shall consist of thirteen members: four members to be selected by the senate president, four members to be selected by the speaker of the house of representatives, and four members to be selected by the chief information officer, with the chief information officer to serve as the chair.
