RELATING TO ENERGY.

EEP/AGR, FIN

Amends the ethanol facility income tax credit to apply to several types of renewable fuel and reduces the aggregate dollar cap for the credit. Establishes a tax credit for the growing of feedstock to be used in renewable fuel production and establishes an aggregate cap. Applies to taxable years beginning after 12/31/12.

Extends the sunset date for the Hawaii economic development task force to 6/30/14. Effective 6/29/12.




Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
