RELATING TO THE BANK OF THE STATE OF HAWAII.
Establishes the bank of the State of Hawaii. Directs the state bank to develop a program to acquire residential property in situations where the mortgagor is an owner-occupant and the mortgagee is a securitized trust that cannot adequately demonstrate that it is a holder in due course.

This three minute policy will be enforced to ensure fairness and adequate consideration to all bills.


Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
