The following measure(s) were previously heard on **January 24, 2012**.

HB 1768 Status	RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC PROCUREMENT CODE. Amends section 103D-707, HRS, to permit an additional post-award remedy if the contract is not fully executed. Allows for rescission of the award and application of remedies provided for in section 103D-706, HRS.	ERB, FIN
HB 1894 Status	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Temporarily authorizes the governor or a county mayor to exempt a construction or design-build procurement from protest concerning the procurement and administrative review of a nonresponsible offeror determination. Requires, as a condition of the exemption, that all bids and proposals, including amendments or revisions, evaluations, and ratings be released for public inspection. Requires the posting of the information on the state or county website.	ERB, FIN
