Statutorily establishes the Division of Aquatic Resources within the Department of Land and Natural Resources. Establishes the emergency environmental workforce. Appropriates funds. Effective July 1, 2012.

**Proposed HD2:** Identifies and transfers money for the information technology transformation initiative. Requires state departments to attempt to sell or donate office equipment to schools, nonprofits, or salvage businesses before disposal. Effective July 1, 2112.

**PAPER:** 2 copies to Room 306 in the State Capitol;



Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
