Permits any interested person with a clear and abiding interest in the well-being of the individual to file a written petition for emergency admission. Requires an independent evaluation of a patient admitted to a licensed psychiatric facility for involuntary hospitalization in

certain circumstances. Removes the word "imminently" from "imminently dangerous". Effective 1/1/50. (SD1)
