SB 2568 RELATING TO THE HOMELESS. HMS/PGM

Status & Testimony

Requires counties to provide information on and access to temporary emergency shelters to homeless individuals and families upon removing them from public property.

SB 2594 RELATING TO THE HOMELESS. HMS/PGM, WAM

Status & Requires the homeless programs office of the department of human services to establish designated safe areas for homeless persons to live until permanent housing becomes available.

Requires the homeless programs office to establish rules and a code of conduct for the designated safe areas; requires partnership with nonprofit and community service organizations and coordination with state and county law enforcement officials for the safety of individuals residing in the designated safe

areas.

SB 2071 RELATING TO CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECKS FOR PGM/HMS, JDL

Status & COUNTY EMPLOYEES.

Allows counties to conduct criminal history checks on

prospective liquor commission employees, employees working with vulnerable adults or seniors, employees for fire, emergency medical services, and emergency management employees.

SB 2407 RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE. HMS/PGM, WAM

Status & Requires the department of human services to implement certain cost-savings programs and technologies in the medicaid,

QUEST, and children's health insurance programs. Requires

report to legislature.

Decision Making to follow, if time permits.
