| <a href="#">SB2361</a><br><a href="#">Status and Testimony</a> | RELATING TO PSEUDOEPHEDRINE.<br>Classifies pseudoephedrine as a schedule V drug that may be dispensed only with a prescription.   | HTH, CPN |
| <a href="#">SB2474</a><br><a href="#">Status and Testimony</a> | RELATING TO HEALTH.<br>Reclassifies pseudoephedrine as a schedule V drug that may only be dispensed with a prescription; exempts cold products that contain other active ingredients, with certain conditions.  | HTH, CPN |
| <a href="#">SB2228</a><br><a href="#">Status and Testimony</a> | RELATING TO PSEUDOEPHEDRINE.<br>Establishes a tracking system for the sale of products containing pseudoephedrine base.   | HTH, CPN |
| <a href="#">SB2477</a><br><a href="#">Status and Testimony</a> | RELATING TO HEALTH.<br>Requires all cellular telephones, including refurbished and remanufactured cellular telephones, sold or leased by a retailer in the State to bear a label that warns consumers of the potential dangers of electromagnetic radiation emitted by cellular phones. | HTH, CPN |
| <a href="#">SB2476</a><br><a href="#">Status and Testimony</a> | RELATING TO HEALTH.<br>Adds definition for "aspartame". Requires a caution statement to be placed on a product label for all food products containing aspartame that are offered for sale or distribution in the State.   | HTH, CPN |

| <a href="#">SB3019</a><br><a href="#">Status and Testimony</a> | RELATING TO HEALTH.<br>Establishes a tax on sugar-sweetened beverages, syrup, and powder with the revenues generated to be deposited into the community health centers special fund and the trauma system special fund.                                     | HTH, WAM |
| <a href="#">SB2422</a><br><a href="#">Status and Testimony</a> | RELATING TO TOBACCO PRODUCTS.<br>Imposes an excise tax on tobacco products, other than large cigars, that is equal to the greater of 70 percent of the wholesale price of, or \$3.20 for, each article or item of tobacco products. Takes effect 10/1/2012. | HTH, WAM |
| <a href="#">SB2569</a><br><a href="#">Status and Testimony</a> | RELATING TO SMOKING.<br>Prohibits smoking within a presumptively reasonable minimum distance of twenty feet from all public bus stops.  | HTH, JDL |
| <a href="#">SB2426</a><br><a href="#">Status and Testimony</a> | RELATING TO TOBACCO PRODUCTS.<br>Prohibits retailers from displaying or storing tobacco products through self-service display or engaging in tobacco product retailing through self-service display.  | HTH, CPN |
| <a href="#">SB3022</a><br><a href="#">Status and Testimony</a> | RELATING TO HEALTH.<br>Increases the excise tax on cigarettes and small cigars.   | HTH, WAM |
| <a href="#">SB1022</a><br><a href="#">Status and Testimony</a> | RELATING TO INVOLUNTARY HOSPITALIZATION.<br>Permits involuntary hospitalization in a psychiatric facility of a sexually violent predator. Defines sexually violent predator.  | HTH, JDL |
