RELATING TO DOMESTIC ABUSE ORDERS.

HUS, JUD

Status

Requires a police officer to order a person to have no contact with a

family or household member for a twenty-four hour period, or longer if the incident occurs on the weekend, when a police officer has

reasonable grounds to believe that there is probable danger of further physical abuse or harm to the family or household member. (SD1)

RELATING TO ACCUSED TO TRANSPORT WITNESS OR

WITNESSES.

Status

Allows family courts to require the accused to transport certain witnesses to any family court proceeding under certain conditions.

RELATING TO CHILD ABUSE.

Status

Provides greater protection for children by amending the offense of promoting child abuse in the second degree to include possession of thirty or more images of child pornography and the content of at least

one image contains a minor younger than the age of twelve, sadomasochistic abuse of a minor, or bestiality involving a minor.

SB 2222, SD2 (SSCR2566) Status

RELATING TO SEXUAL IMAGES PRODUCED BY MINORS.

HUS, JUD

Prohibits adults from soliciting minors to electronically transmit nude images of minors; prohibits minors from electronically transmitting nude images of themselves or other minors, or soliciting other minors to do so; prohibits persons from possessing a nude image transmitted by a minor, but makes it an affirmative defense that the recipient made reasonable efforts to destroy the transmitted nude image. Effective
