SB2207 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS. Provides for fair compensation when leased public land for agricultural or pastoral uses is withdrawn, condemned, or taken for public purposes.	WLH/JDL, WAM
SB2524 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO HAIKU VALLEY. Establishes the Haiku Valley cultural preserve commission to provide policy and management oversight of the Haiku Valley cultural preserve. Initiates process of conveying Haiku valley in fee simple to the department of land and natural resources.	WLH/JDL, WAM
SB2851 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO VESSELS. Clarifies responsibility for disposing of vessels and amends the description of an abandoned vessel.	WLH/JDL, WAM
SB2852 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO AQUATIC RESOURCE VIOLATIONS. Provides for transformative administrative penalty alternatives and an enhanced collection mechanism for outstanding fines and penalties resulting from aquatic resource violations.	WLH/JDL, WAM
SB2853 Status and Testimony	RELATING TO ACCRETED LANDS. Clarifies that land accreted after May 20, 2003, shall be public land except as otherwise provided by law.	WLH/JDL, WAM

the export of raw or unprocessed sandalwood timber. Establishes
DLNR policies regarding sandalwood.
